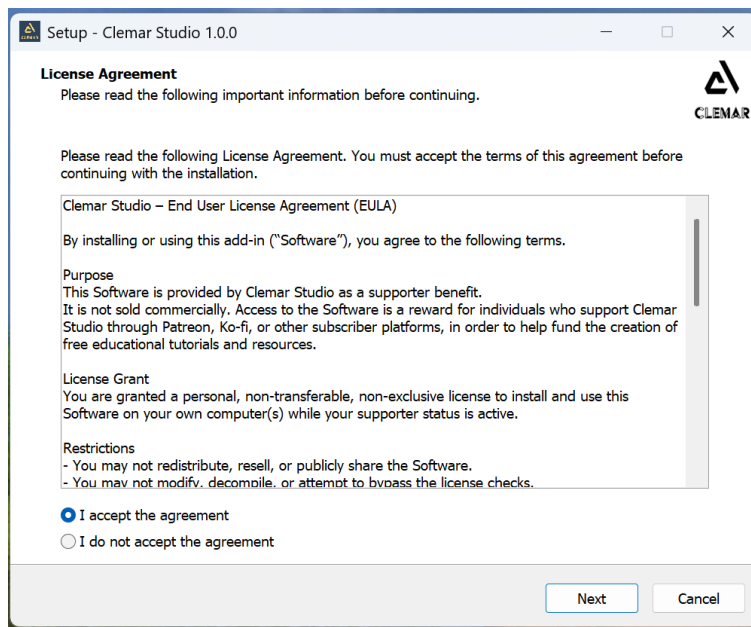

Option 1 — Auto Installation Guide

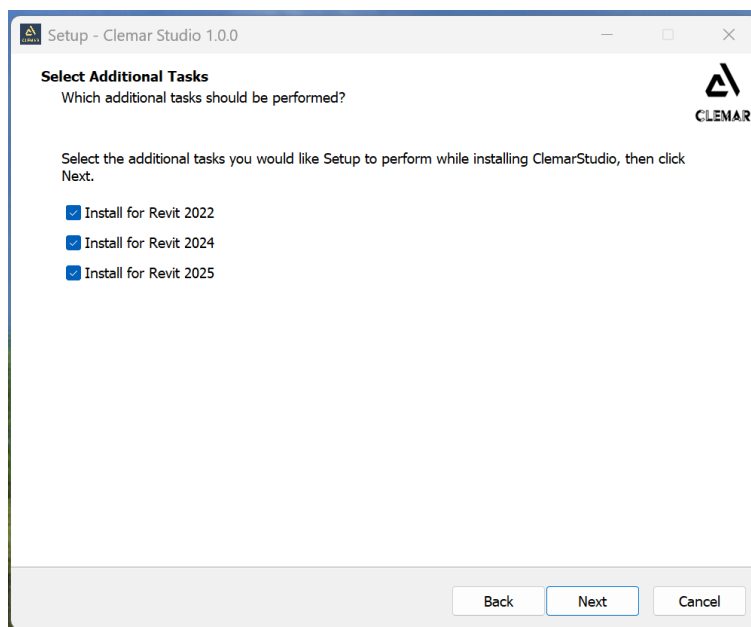
Please close all Revit Program before installing

Part 1 – Accept Agreement

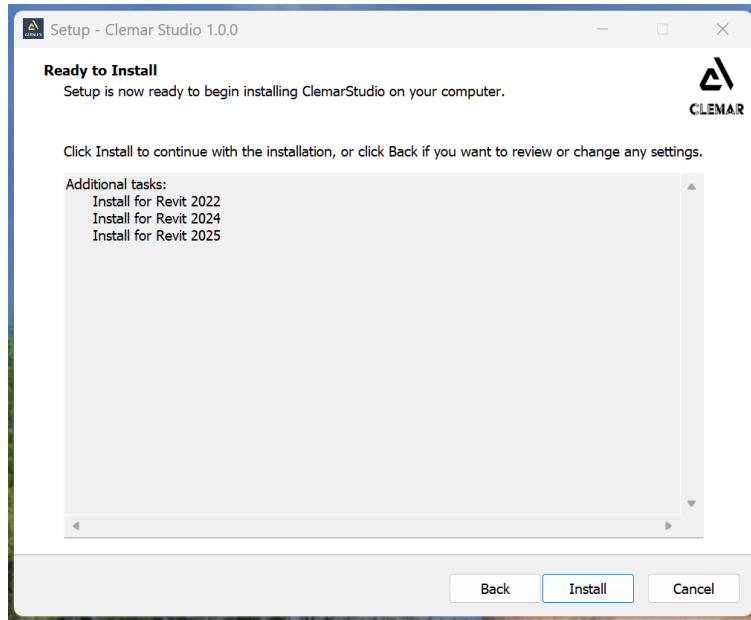


Part 2 – Select Revit version to install the Add-in

It will automatically detect the Revit Version installed on the computer. Just check all if you want to use it in all versions.

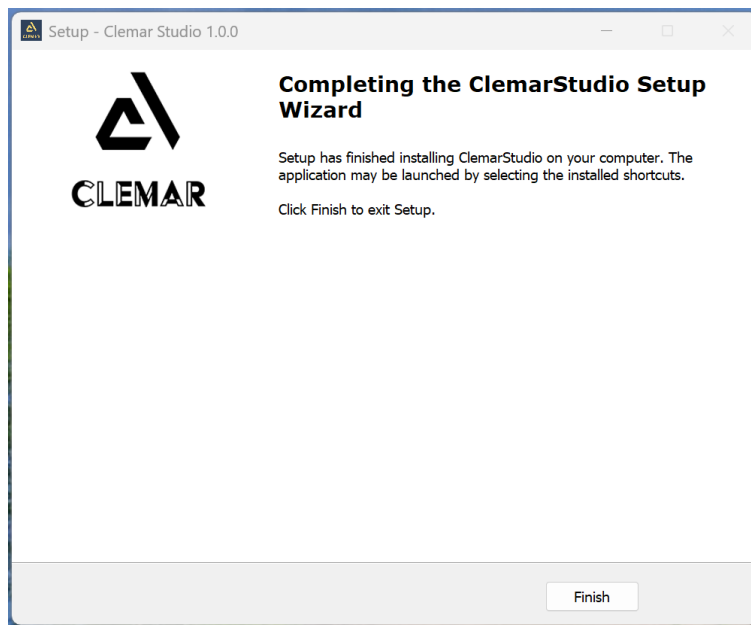


Part 3 – Review and confirm the installation

Press finish to exit the installation.

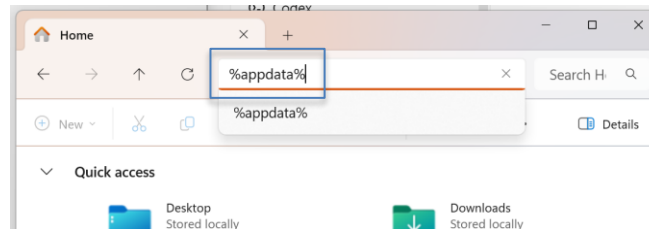


Option 2 — Manual Installation Guide

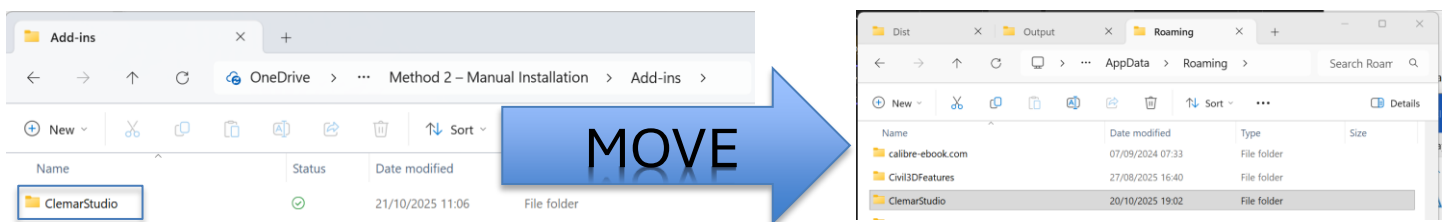
Welcome to the **Cleamar Studio Add-ins** Manual Installation Guide. If your company computer restricts the use of .exe files, you can still install the add-in by following the steps below. Please proceed carefully to ensure smooth and successful installation.

Part 1 – Copy the **Add-ins** Folder

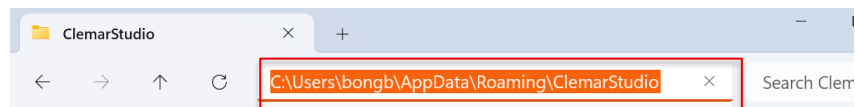
1. Open **File Explorer**.
2. Type **%AppData%** in the address bar and press **Enter**.
3. Open the folder:



4. Copy **Add-ins/CleamarStudio** into that location



5. Copy the whole path of **CleamarStudio** folder for Step 2 use.


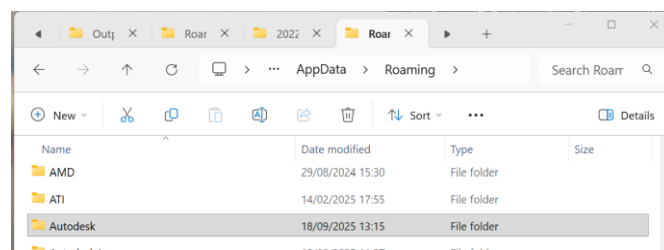


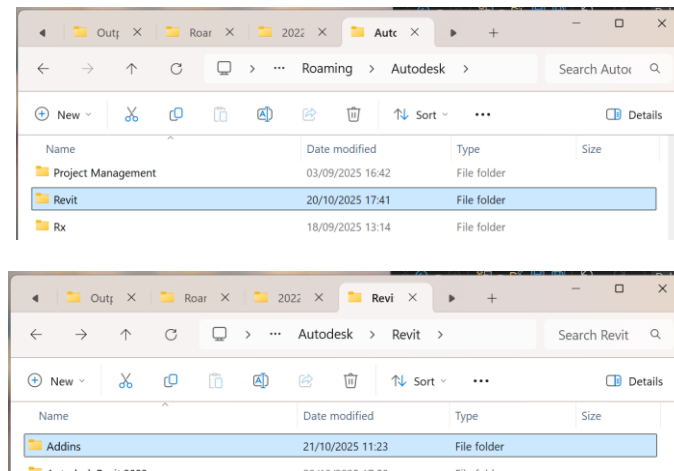

Part 2 – Copy the **Connector** File

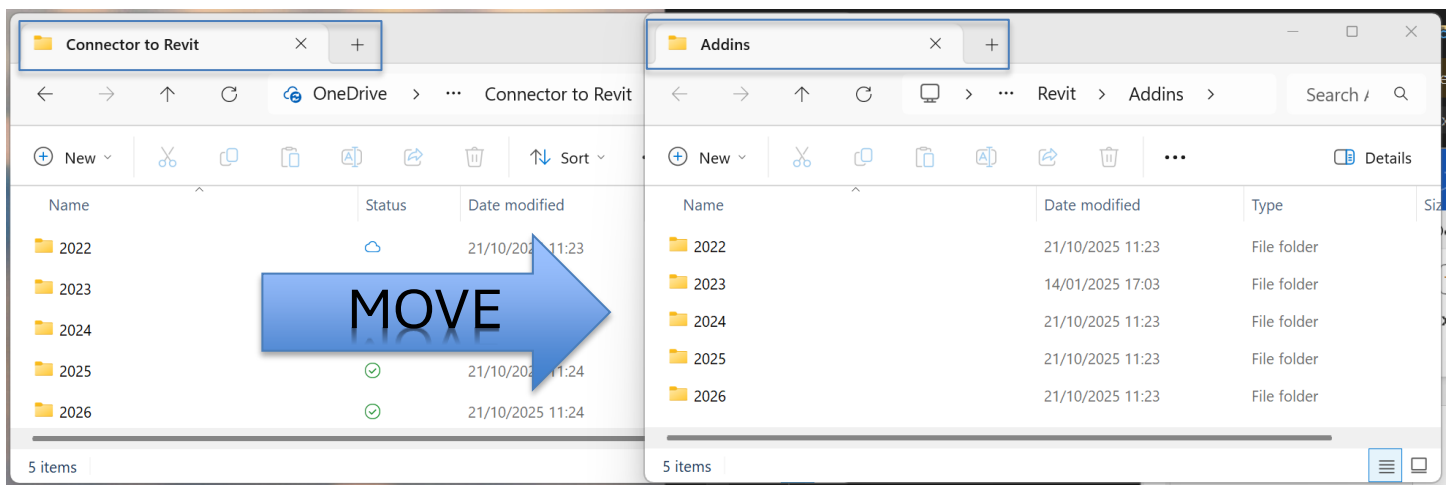
1. Open **Connector to Revit**.
2. Go to **%appdata%** in file browser as above, find **Autodesk -> Revit -> Addins**

OPEN

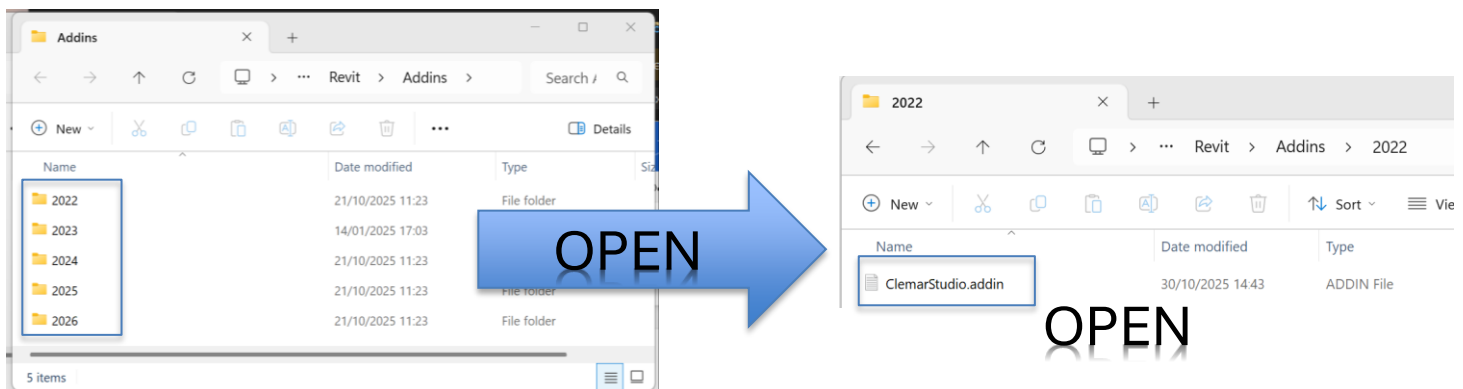





3. Copy **all** folders inside it to the same **Addins** directory above.



4. Open **ClemarStudio.addin** inside EACH folder with notepad



5. Paste the path to **ClemarStudio.addin** from **Part 1 Step 5** to the version you required (e.g. 2024, etc.)
(replacing the red highlighted with your copied path)


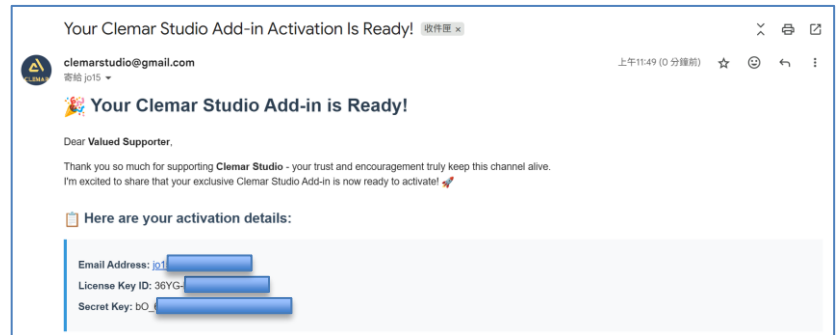

1. Launch **Revit** — you'll see a new tab called **Clemar Studio**.
2. Click any function button, then enter the activation details you received by email:

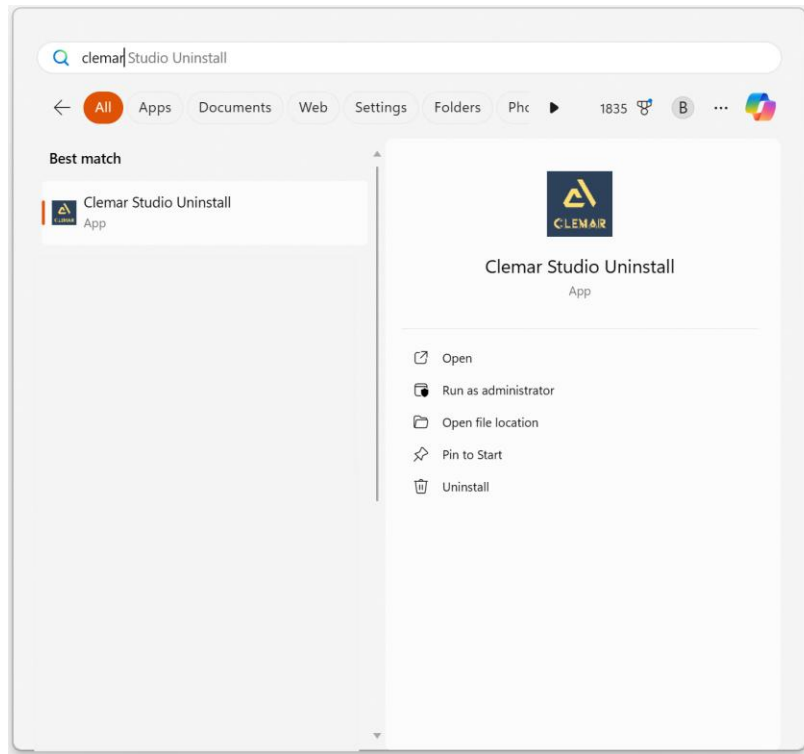
3. Click **Activate**. (An internet connection is required for first-time activation.)

Uninstall

Option 1 – Delete from start menu



If you use option 1 auto installation to install the plugin, you can find a Uninstaller in the start menu. Click to uninstall.

Option 2 – Manual deletes from folder

To uninstall manually, delete all copied files from option 2 in your files explorer.
